Hindustan Sanitaryware to add capacity

Bangalore, May 23

With consumers changing the look of the bathroom every 8-10 years and almost doubling its size (from 50 sq ft to 100 sq ft), sanitaryware products manufacturer, Hindustan Sanitaryware & Industries Ltd (HSIL) is looking at a 25-30 per cent CAGR over the next five years. The company is planning to invest close to Rs 100 crore during this fiscal for debottlenecking and adding capacity its ceramic plant in Andhra Pradesh, Mr Sandip Somany, Joint Managing Director, HSIL told *Business Line*.

The combined capacity of the company's two plants (AP and Haryana) is 28 lakh pieces a year which would be upped by 25 per cent by the end of this fiscal. The company is also investing in debottlenecking its glass business in Hyderabad, where it will raise the glass capacity by 10 per cent (from 1,000 tonnes a day to 1,100 t).
